- (1) The posts are purely temporary on contractual basis and can be terminated at any time without notice;
- (2) Candidates of reserved category will be eligible for age relaxation as per Govt. norms and necessary documents should be attached to this effect.
- (3) Candidates must submit all their certificates and mark-sheets alongwith the filled-in application form. Candidates applying for Attendant (Female) must submit their Certificate of Residence obtained from the local Tahasildar.
- (4) Candidates having the Certificates of education or training from Universities/Boards of outside State, they will only be eligible for engagement after verification of genuineness of their educational/training qualification from concerned University/ Institution from which they have obtained the Degree or Diploma.

**Age Limit :-**

The candidates must be below 32 years and above 21 years of age as on 01.01.2018 provided that maximum age limit shall be relaxed by 5 years in case of candidates belonging to SC, ST, SEBC/OBC, Women candidates. In case of PH candidates the upper age shall be relaxed by 10 years as per GA Deptt. Notification No. 33068/Gen., dated 27.10.1989 (Odisha Civil Service, fixation of upper age limit Rule, 1989) and SEBC Act.

**Modalities for Selection of Candidates for different vacant posts.**

The Red Cross School for the Blind is a Special School managed by the Indian Red Cross Society, Ganjam District Branch and running under the Grant-in-Aid fold of the SSEPD Department, Govt. of Odisha. It's a residential institution and is oldest among all in the State.

In its Meeting dated 10.04.2018, the District level Selection Committee chaired by the Collector, Ganjam has formulated the following modalities for selection of candidates, for the vacant posts of Red Cross School for the Blind.

**Asst. Teacher ( Trained Intermediate) :**

HSC or equivalent : 20%,  
+2 or equivalent : 30%,  
Diploma in Spl. Education (V.I.) : 50%

**Mobility Teacher :**

HSC or equivalent : 20%,  
+2 or equivalent : 30%,  
Diploma / Degree (whichever is higher) in Orientation & Mobility : 50%

**Music Teacher (Vocal & Instrumental) :**

HSC or equivalent : 50%,  
I.Mus (in the relevant category) : 50%,

**Craft Teacher**

HSC or equivalent : 50%,  
I.T.I. : 40%, Skill Test : 50%

**Matron / Warden :**

+3 / Graduation or equivalent : 50%,  
Diploma / Digree (whichever is higher) in Special Education (V.I.) : 50%

**Clerk-cum-Accountant :**

HSC or equivalent : 20%  
+2 or equivalent : 30%  
Graduation : 50%

**Attendant (Female) (only for candidates of Ganjam District)**

The candidate must have passed Class VIII examination. Preference will be given to the widow candidates. The candidates having class VIII qualification of the village over which the school is located will be given 1<sup>st</sup> preference. Second in case of non-availability in village, then candidates of the concerned Block shall be taken into

consideration for selection as second preference. In case of non-availability of suitable candidates of the concerned Block then third will be given to the candidates of the District. The candidates must submit the Residential Certificate to this effect. If there are more than one candidate of particular preferred category then candidates upto 1:10 (maximum) shall be called for interview / skill test basing on the percentage of the marks in class VIII exam. If there is only one candidate out of the preferred category then there is no need of interview / skill test.

**Skill Test / Interview of Candidates :-**

After preparation of the Merit List on the basis of the above weightage of marks obtained in academic and professional qualifications, the candidates at the ratio of 1 : 10 will be called for original certificates verification and Skill Test / Interview / Presentation. The candidates for all the posts will appear for a SKILL TEST / Interview, before the Committee appointed by the Collector. Only the candidates qualified in the Skill Test are eligible for the selection process. The candidate securing the highest marks in career as per the weightage among the successful candidates on skill test, will be selected for the post. The skill test is of qualifying nature, but the marks will not be added in preparing the Merit List. The Committee suggested the following skill test for different posts.

Asst. Teacher (Trained Intermediate)	:	Teaching in Bharati & English Braille
Music Teacher (Vocal & Instrumental)	:	Theory and practical on classical Music in related category
Clerk-cum-Accountant	:	Computer / accounting skill test
Mobility Teacher	:	Skill presentation in related field
Matron / Warden	:	Skill test in Spl. Education
Attendant (Female)	:	Interview (if required)

The Collector, Ganjam will constitute separate Expert Committees for conducting the Skill Test in related fields for all the category of posts.

**Other Conditions :**

1. The aspiring candidates must obtain the prescribed application form, duly signed by the DSSO, Ganjam, from the Office of the HM, Red Cross School for the Blind, Ambapua, BERHAMPUR-760011 on cash payment of Rs. 100/-. Application obtained in any other manner will not be entertained.
2. The candidates must attach the Money Receipt for Rs. 100/- issued, alongwith the filled-in application;

3. The envelope containing the application form and enclosures must be sent by Registered Post to the **Dist. Social Security Officer, Ganjam District, CHATRAPUR – 761020, Dist. Ganjam**, so as to reach on or before **28.05.2018**.
4. The envelope containing the application and enclosures must be superscribed about the post applied for.
5. Applicants for Attendant (Female) must attach the Certificate and Mark Sheet of Class VIII and Certificate of Residence issued by the concerned Tahasildar, otherwise the application will be rejected.
6. Applicants must affix their recent passport size photograph on the space provided in the application form.
7. Mere submitting the application for the vacant posts does not entitle any right of the candidates for employment.
8. Applications received without the requisite documents, photograph, money receipt or applications received after the stipulated date will summarily be rejected.
