

Changes in National Scholarship Portal (NSP) for A.Y. 2019-20

Institute Related Changes

1. All the Institutes, with valid AISHE/DISE/NCVT/SCVT codes, are required to **re-register or register afresh** on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) so that they can verify the application form of their students.
2. Institutes (with valid AISHE/DISE/NCVT/SCVT codes) are required to fill Institute Nodal Officer (INO) Registration Form, and submit it to District/State Nodal officer of any scheme onboarded at NSP
3. Exceptional cases are highlighted in Application verification form, while verifying the student application

District/State Nodal Officer Related Changes

1. Facility to verify and approve Institute Nodal Officer (INO) Registration.
2. Facility to remove incorrect AISHE/DISE/NCVT/SCVT code from previously registered institutes.
3. Facility to check status of individual INO registration.
4. Status report of INO registrations in the entire district in DNO login.
5. Facility to view log of student application submission has been provided to State Nodal Officers. They can do so by providing the application ID of the student.

Student Related Changes

1. In cases where 'Institute State' is different from 'Domicile State' of the 'student', scanned copy of 'Bonafide certificate', certified from Institute is to be uploaded with the application.
2. Aadhaar exception handling mechanism is devised, in case of non-Aadhaar applications:
 - a. Applicants are required to upload the scanned copy of first page of bank passbook with photograph, during registration.
 - b. Applicants are required to upload scanned copy of 'Bonafide Certificate', certified from Institute.
3. The student will get the option to generate 'Bonafide certificate' through the system, after filling in all the details and selecting the scheme.
4. The student has the option to withdraw the registration in case he/she has filled incorrect details while registration or in case he/she has not submitted the application on NSP.
