3. Eligible condition

- i. Officers who have retired from Govt Services on attaining the age of superannuation and below the age of Sixty-five years having good service records and physically fit for reengagement.
- ii. Officers against whom department proceedings or criminal cases contemplated /pending or who have been penalized for misconduct during the period of proceeding five years will not be eligible for consideration.

4. Selection Process

- i. Selection process will be made through open advertisement
- ii. There shall be selection committee as may be decided by the appointment authority for the posts required to be filled up by re-employment.

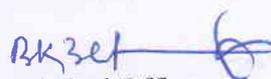
5. Tenure, Terms and Condition

- i. The re-employment shall be made initially for a period of two years and can be extended for subsequent period of two years with spells of one year each subject to satisfactory performance up to total period of four years not beyond the age of sixty-five years of age in any case or fill the posts are filled up by regular process whichever is earlier.
- ii. Re-employed Officers will be entitled to pay and other allowances as determined by the administrative department/ appointing authority with the concurrence of the finance department
- iii. Re-employed officers shall be Governed by the provisions of Odisha Government Servants conduct rules- 1975 and shall be liable to be proceeded against for their misconduct omissions and commission as per the provision under the Odisha, Pension Rules 1992
- iv. The re-employment can be terminated at any time by the respective employed Officers by giving one-month notice on the contrary if any re-employed officer desires to resign, he shall do so by giving one month written notice to the competent authority.

6. Retention of Govt. Quarter

As provided in the Resolution No 19637/ Gem DATED 30.03.1999 during the period of the contract appointment, the appointee may be accommodated in the Govt. quarter subject to the availability provided, he pays normal rent as applicable to a Govt. Servant overriding effect.

The provisions of this resolution will supersede all previous executive structure of the Govt. pertaining to re-employment of retired persons.

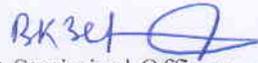
