



PRIME MINISTER'S EMPLOYMENT GENERATION PROGRAMME (PMEGP)

The objective of the programme is to generate employment opportunities in rural as well as urban areas through setting up of new self-employment ventures / projects / micro enterprises. The details of the scheme are furnished below:

Eligibility conditions of Beneficiaries:

- Individual above 18 years of age setting up new projects.
- Only one person from one family eligible. The 'family' includes self and spouse.
- There is no ceiling on income.
- The applicant should have passed at least VIII standard for setting up of project above `10 lakh in the manufacturing sector and above `5 lakh in the business / service sector
- Only new projects for activities excluding the negative list of village industries notified are eligible for assistance under the Scheme. Existing units which have already availed subsidy under any other scheme are not eligible.

(Note - Those who have availed any other Capital Subsidy under Central/State Government NOT eligible)

- Amount of Bank Loan** : 90-95% of the sanctioned project cost.
- Rate of Interest** : Normal Rate of Interest as applicable to the enterprise from time to time.
- Repayment Period** : 3 to 7 Years
- Nodal Agency** : The Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) is the nodal agency at the national level.
- Implementing Agency** : DIC, KVIC, KVIB & Coir Board

Documents to be uploaded online:

- Aadhaar card
- Project Report/ Project summery
- Educational certificate
- Caste certificate if applicable
- Passport size photograph
- Special category certificate if required
- Population certificate from appropriate authority

EDP Training:

Entrepreneurship Development Training for a period of 2 weeks (10 Days) is mandatory for all the beneficiaries. The DIC, Ganjam is conducting the Entrepreneurship Development Programmes throughout the year at different places inside the District. Applications for these programmes can be submitted through Industries Promotion Officers at blocks level or to DIC, Ganjam, directly.

Negative list of activities

- Industry / Business connected with productions / processing / sale of meat or intoxicant items like Beedi / Pan / Cigar / Cigarette etc.
- Industry / Business connected with cultivation, sericulture, horticulture, floriculture.
- Manufacture of Polythene carry bags of less than 20 microns / containers of recycled plastic.
- Processing of Pashmina Wool and products involving hand spinning and hand weaving coming under purview of Khadi Certification Rule.
- Rural Transport (except Auto rickshaw, House boat, tourist boat in A & N Islands and except house boat, Shikara & Tourist Boats in Jammu & Kashmir and Cycle Rickshaw.)
- CNG Auto Rickshaw will be allowed only in A & N Islands and NER with the approval of Chief Secretary of the State on merit.
