1. Milestone dates for tendering

 - iii. Opening of price bid (To be intimated to all the pre-qualified bidders separately.)
2. The bidders shall have to submit their bids either physically in the tender deposition box or through registered post / Speed post / Courier service on or before the above mentioned scheduled date & time. For bids being deposited through registered post the Divisional Forest Officer, Ghumsur South Division will not be responsible for any late receipt of the bid documents. Bidders need to enclose the acknowledgement receipt in support of payment of cost of **tender document charges of Rs.4,000/- in the form of Demand Draft from a scheduled Bank drawn in favour of the Divisional Forest Officer, Ghumsur South Division, Bhanjanagar payable at Bhanjanagar.**
3. The bidders should enclose **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs.10,000/- in the form of Demand Draft from a scheduled Bank drawn in favour of the Divisional Forest Officer, Ghumsur South Division, Bhanjanagar payable at Bhanjanagar.** Bid document without proper EMD and tender document charges will summarily be rejected.

4. 7. The bidders will have to provide components/ equipment in strict compliance with the manufacturer/ makes/ brand of BIS standard. All the bidders need to provide unconditional acceptance of this by signing each page of the schedule as a token of acceptance. Non-compliance to this will lead to rejection of the bid documents without assigning any reason thereof and the bids will not be further considered for evaluation.
8. All the pages of the Tender Documents should be signed by the tenderer or else it is liable for cancellation.
9. Defect liability period will be for a period of one year from the date of installation and commissioning.
10. The entire work needs to be completed within a period of fifteen days from the date of issue of work order.
11. Order and Delivery Report/ Certificate towards proof of having supplied and installed of Solar Street Light (High Mast) to any State/ Central Government Organizations within the last 3 (Three) years.

14. Registration of the Agency/Firm/Dealer/Supplier from DIC/NSIC or similar originations.

I. INSTRUCTION OF BIDDERS

- a. The bidders are expected to submit the Earnest Money Deposit, Technical Bid and Financial Bid in hard copy in the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Ghumsur South Division, Bhanjanagar or by Speed Post. Financial Bid should be separately sealed in the envelope and to be submitted as per the format mentioned herein.
- b. Products of Chinese companies will not be accepted.
- c. Bidders should quote the price as per the specification enclosed in the tender paper.
- d. Bidders should submit the technical bid with sketch of the Same.
- e. **Price of Solar Street Light should be quoted inclusive of cost of transportation, installation, accessories, all the taxes and included Annual Maintenance work, with no cost paid by the undersigned for maintenance work during 01st year maintenance after completion of warrantee period and next year can be add the cost for maintenance.**
- f. In order to obtain first- hand information about the assignment the local conditions/ constraints and concept of the entire project, it is advisable that the bidder visits the site to acquaint with the site conditions etc.
- g. The bidder will have to keep its offer valid for 60 days of the opening of the technical bid and in the case of withdrawal before that date the earnest money amount will be forfeited to the department.
- h. The expenses on preparing the proposals, visiting the site, attending the pre-submission meeting and negotiating the contract etc. will not be reimbursed.

II. METHOD OF APPLYING

- a. If the application is made by the individual, it shall be signed above his full type written name & current address.
- b. If a proprietary firm makes the application, it shall be signed by the proprietor above his full type written name & the full name of his firm with its current address.
- c. If the application is made by a firm in partnership, it shall be signed by all the partners of the firm with their full name and current addresses or alternatively by a partner holding power of attorney shall be enclosed with the prequalification document. A certified copy of partnership deed and current address of all the partners of the firms shall also be enclosed with the prequalification document.
- d. If a limited company or corporation makes the application, a duly authorized person shall sign it.

III. SUBMISSION AND OPENING OF BIDS

- a. No tender will be valid unless accompanied by the stipulated amount of earnest money.
- b. At the advertised time and place, all bids received for the contract shall be opened by the officer inviting the tender (or any other officer authorized by him) in person, in the presence of the bidder or their representative who may choose to attend. No overwritings shall be done but corrections where necessary shall be neatly scored out and rewritten and corrections shall be duly attested prior to the submission of the bids.
- c. At the time of opening of tender, one Additional Officer/ one office Assistant shall also be present invariably to render necessary assistance.
- d. Attendance of the bidders or their authorized representatives shall be noted down in the register to be maintained for this purpose. Rates and or conditions of each of the bids shall be read out before the persons present and their signatures obtained on each of the tender document.
- e. The officer opening the tender documents would initial on each and every bids and the serial numbers of such tender documents with reference to total tender documents noted on each bid document.

The initials shall be recorded on the page containing the financial bids.

- f. Each and every correction or overwriting shall be initialled and number of such corrections noted on the respective pages. The bidders are advised to properly seal the tender document papers in their own interest.
- g. The earnest money of the lowest bidder shall be retained till the tender document is accepted and agreement executed. The earnest money of the remaining bidders whose tender is not accepted shall be refunded after the agreement is executed. However, irrespective of the decision on the tender documents the earnest money of all the bidders shall be refundable on expiry of the validity period specified in the Notice Inviting Tender (NIT).
- h. Each bidder shall supply the name, residence and place of business of the person or persons giving the tender document and shall be signed by the bidder with his usual signature. When a partnership firm gives tender document then the full names of all the partners shall be furnished. An attested copy of the constitution of the firm and the register number of the firm shall be furnished. In such a case the tender document must be signed separately by each partner or in the event of the absence of any partner must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to be so. - i. The bidders shall also give the following information invariably on cover containing the tender document

- j. Earnest money which has been deposited for a particular work will not ordinarily be adjusted towards the earnest money for another work.
- k. The tender documents shall be opened at the time and place stated above by the officer issuing this notice in the presence of the bidders or their duly authorized representatives who may choose to attend. The officer under unavoidable circumstances may depute another officer in his absence to receive and open the tender documents on his behalf.
- l. The technical bid in the presence of the tenderers or their authorized representatives, who choose to be present, will be opened on 20.01.2026 at 11.30 AM. The financial bids will be opened after evaluation of the technical proposals and on a date and time to be notified to such of the bidders who are technically eligible.
- m. The Division Level Purchase Committee constituted by Divisional Forest Officer, Ghumsur South Division will scrutinize the tender documents and reserves the right to recommend for acceptance any of the bids.
- n. The particulars of the proposed work given are bare minimum and must be considered only as advance information to assist the applicant.
- o. Enhancement or Curtailment in the quantum of the work will not vitiate the contract.
- p. Conditional bids are liable to be rejected.
- q. Canvassing for support in any form for the acceptance of any tender document is strictly prohibited.
- r. If the bidder whose tender is accepted fails to deposit the security amount and to execute the agreement within the notified period for any reason whatever, earnest money deposit with the tender document shall be forfeited and acceptance of the bids cancelled.
- s. The payment will be made through online mode only.
- t. Deduction of GST TDS / Income Tax TDS at source shall be done as per the law. It is open to the bidder as the case may be to make an application to the officer concerned and obtain from him a certificate authorizing the prayer to deduct tax such lower rate or deduct no tax as may be appropriate to his case. Such certificate will be valid for the period specified therein unless the officer concerned cancels it. The bidder whose tender document has been accepted will have to execute the agreement in the prescribed form within seven days of the receipt of the communication of the acceptance of his tender. BANK GUARANTEE/SECURITY DEPOSIT

- a) The supplier shall be responsible for any rectification of problems within the warranty period of 5 (five) years to make the unit fully functional. Replacement of any parts within the warranty period shall be on the part of the supplier. Any breakage due to wild animals / theft shall not be included in the scope of warranty.
- b) The supplier shall attend / rectify the defect within 10 days and for any break down period for more than 10 calendar days, shall be added to the warranty period. Failure to attend/ rectify the defect within 10 calendar days after notifying, purchaser will rectify the defect from any other agency and supplier has to pay for this and purchaser will forfeit the Bank Guarantee/Security Deposit.
- c) The supplier should provide the service report to the purchaser. After Award of contract to the successful bidder, the supplier shall deposit 3% of the contract value in form of demand draft / FD Pledge in favour of Divisional Forest Officer, Ghumsur South Forest Division for Bank Guarantee/Security Deposit within 30 days of Award of contract. After receipt of the Security Deposit only payment shall be made to the supplier. SERVICE AND MAINTENANCE DURING WARRANTY PERIOD

The supplier will be responsible to provide service and maintenance during warranty period of 5 years as and when required at the place of respective instruments installed.

ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25% of the bid quantity at the time placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during continuity of the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
- Payment shall only be done after submission of completion certificate and verification by the purchaser.
- Scope of supply includes Transportation, Installation, Commissioning and GST Charges to be included in the bid.
- **COMPLETION TIME: 30 days from generation of work Order. Non-completion within the date as in the contract shall attract penal charges as deem proper.**
- All bidder willing to participate in the Technical Bid, shall have to supply their prototype sample at the Divisional Forest Officer, Ghumsur South Division for checking the efficacy of the system. Only those bidders who pass the field test shall be accepted for technical qualification. The product shall reach the office on or before the last day of the bid closing. Sample shall not be received after the due date whatsoever the reason may be.

- The bidder the at their own arrangement shall take back the prototype sample along with accessories after generation of contract. This office shall not take any responsibility for returning of the samples.
- The bidders are requested to submit the details about their product in their letter head, duly during submission of technical bid. Basing on their product specification, and requirement as pre the terms and conditions in the BID technical evaluation shall be made.
- The Authority reserves the right to withdraw or relax any of the terms and conditions mentioned above so as to overcome any problem encountered at a larger stage at the sole discretion of the authority.

FORFEITURE OF EMD/ SECURITY DEPOSIT ETC.:

If the successful bidder / agency refuses/ fails to accept Work Order issued by DFO, Ghumsur South Division or the work order assigned to the agency/ bidder are not done as per the scope of work/ schedule of requirement, EMD/ Security Deposit will be forfeited. The work will then be allotted to the L2 bidder and the financial loss sustained shall be recovered from the L1 bidder.

REJECTION OF THE BID:

- (a) The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, formats, terms & conditions in the bid document. Failure to furnish complete information or false information/documents shall result in rejection of bid.
- (b) In respect of interpretation/ clarification of this bid document and in respect of any matter relating to this bid document, the decision of DFO, Ghumsur South Division shall be final.
- (c) The bidder will have to furnish the requisite document as specified in the bid document, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected.
- (d) The bids without EMD will be summarily rejected.
- (e) The bids received after specified date & time shall not be considered.
- (f) The bids received through fax/ email or any other mode other than specified in the tender document shall not be considered.

BLACKLISTING:

Company/ Firm blacklisted by Government/ PSU/ Corporate organisation are not eligible to participate in the bidding process. If at any stage of bidding process or during the currency of work order, such information comes to the knowledge of DFO, Ghumsur South Division, it shall have right to reject the bid or cancel the work order, as the case may be without any compensation to the bidder.

ARBITRATION

All disputes or difference whatsoever arising between the parties out of or relating the meaning and operation or effect of the work order or the breach thereof shall be settled by reference to the arbitration as per Indian Arbitration Act.

IV. TENDER PROCEDURE

The tender will be in two-bid system: Part-A & Part-B.

Part-A will contain EMD, Tender document charges and the details as mentioned. If all the clauses of part-A is complied, then only Part- B will be opened.
